## A Glimpse Of What Is Working At Laclede

- I keep the matter of growth before the people consistently.
- I stress that it is God's will to grow and that the lack of growth spells death for the church.
- I emphasize that attendance in Sunday School (to study the Word) and Worship (to hear the Word preached) are means of grace.
- We started a **Children's Sunday School** where none existed prior.
- I have at least one "big" Sunday Emphasis per month. This can be a "holiday" emphasis or the creation of a theme for the month. Many Sundays are natural derivatives of holidays on the Christian Calendar.
- I try to **promote an atmosphere of love** for one another. Simply said, people want to know they are loved. Anyone who is absent gets contacted by someone. And, this pastor contacts, by one means or another, everyone that was absent. I "pester" people my congregation with visits, phone calls, letters, cards, etc. I live 92 miles from my church, but I still stay in contact.
- I try to embellish an **attitude that serving the Lord is fun**. Building the Kingdom is fun. Building the attendance is fun. Raising money is fun. We really are the ones having fun. . .not the world.
- Work the enrollment and membership list. Often we are made to believe that in order to grow we must get new people. Well, that is part of the growth formula, but it is very rewarding to reestablish people that have fallen away. Especially at Laclede we have found this to be a successful means of growth. Thank you for letting me share.

#### **Missional Strategy**

#### **A New Year and New Priorities**

January 2011 will mark three years for me serving as District Missionary for the Illinois District. In that time, I have worked with three churches in ReFocus efforts and with five NewStart churches as well. I have assisted with TIPS (Transitional Interim Pastor) presentations in two of our churches, recruited pastors to attend New Church University, and worked hand in hand with our Mission Strategy Team to provide further training and funding for our churches.

Our contract with New Church Specialties has not changed during this time. It provided for 50 days of service each year. This was in addition to my full-time service as pastor at Casey. We've always known that there was much more work to be done than 50 days could allow. While serving as pastor at Casey, I always kept my work there as a priority. Yet, I have grown to enjoy the work of encouraging pastors and leaders and seeking to serve the mission of the District. As you know, I recently made the difficult decision to resign there in order to seek a new direction from the Lord. I am so thankful to Dr. Spruce and so many of you who have prayed for me, my family, and the church at Casey during this time.

In their most recent meeting, the District Advisory Board accepted a proposal to expand the District Missionary role to that of District Missional Strategy Director, providing for the extension of this work to 150 days per year. Briefly the work will include the following priorities:

- 1. To work closely with the District Superintendent in implementing the Mission Strategy of the District.
- 2. To act as chairman of the Mission Strategy Team, communicating the vision and agenda of the Mission Strategy Team across the District, and to overseeing the implementation of its strategy.
- 3. To develop networks on the District to promote prayer, coaching, and church planting.
- 4. To help launch a church multiplication movement on the Illinois District.
- 5. To assist the District Superintendent in the recruitment and assessment of NewStart pastors.
- 6. To provide assessment and training for pastors and churches in the areas of Church Health and ReFocus (using the resources of New Church Specialties).
- 7. To oversee the planning of training events promoting church health and missional strategies for pastors and church leaders on the District.
- 8. To regularly report progress to the Mission Strategy Team and the District Advisory Board at scheduled meetings.

I also believe God is calling me to enter into the work of church planting myself. More than anything else, this part of the District Missionary's work has captured my heart and imagination. I really can't see trying to lead the District to plant more churches without my own personal commitment in the work. I have found some part-time employment (at Starbucks) in Effingham and I am beginning to build relationships there. Candy and I are hoping to sell our home soon and relocate there to begin gathering friends to form the core of a new church.

I am humbled and thankful for the faith the District leadership has placed in me to lead this work. God has truly captured my heart with a missional vision for our district that I can now fully pursue. However, this work depends on all of us and adjusting our priorities according to God's purposes. How can we begin this new year together committed to do so?

First, pray. Pray that the Lord of the harvest will send laborers into the harvest field that is the Illinois District Church of the Nazarene. In Luke 10:2, Jesus teaches his disciples to begin his mission with this commandment. Set your cell phone alarm to remind you to pray each day at 10:02. Imagine the impact of hundreds of Nazarenes calling out to God each day for harvest hands. Remember to pray as well for our pastors and churches for a genuine spiritual renewal that will empower us for the work to come.

Second, ask God if he is sending you to be part of a new church plant. As the disciples prayed for laborers, the next passage found them being sent *as those laborers* into the harvest fields themselves. Tell Christ you are willing to go and to adjust your priorities in any way necessary should he call you to join him in this work. I believe the hope of our District lies in our obedience to Christ's call.

Finally, commit, or recommit yourself to making a new disciple this year. Ask God to give you the names of two people who are not presently following Christ. Pray for them daily and grow your friendship with them. Listen to their stories, discern their needs, and seek to bless them. Open your life to them as well. Be vulnerable and real, confessing your own dependence on Christ. In time, ask them if they'd be interested in reading through one of the gospels together and discussing it weekly. Let God use you to plant the seed of his word in their lives, and trust him to grow it to full fruitfulness.

2011 is a new year, and should we allow Christ to lead us in new ways, we will see new progress toward a new Illinois!
